

Prevalence

ARC is higher in females than in males, and both showed a steady rise with advanced age.

In males, the prevalence of any cataract ranged from 6.71% (95% CI = 5.06-8.83) in people aged 45-49 years to 73.01% (95% CI = 65.78-79.2) in elderly aged 85-89 years.











Signs & Symptoms

- Clouded, blurred or dim vision.
- Increasing difficulty with vision at night.
- Sensitivity to light and glare.
- Need brighter light for reading and other activities.
- Seeing "halos" around lights.
- Frequent changes in prescription.
- Fading or yellowing of colors.
- Double vision in a single eye.


