

Introduction



—There were approximately 38 million people across the globe with HIV/AIDS (till 2020). Of these,


36.2 million were adults and 1.8 million were children (<15 years old).

AIDS Treatment

Various researches are still going on for the treatment of AIDS, but there's **no** specific treatment of it.

HIV antivirals (Anti Retroviral Therapy-ART) can suppress HIV to slow progression of infection. And it's currently used as a medical treatment.
