5 A'S OF ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE

- Anomia Inability to remember names of things.
- Apraxia misuse of objects because of failure to identify them.
- Agnosia inability to recognise familiar objects, sound, taste and other sensations.
- Amnesia memory loss.
- Aphasia inability to express oneself through speech.

Signs, Symptoms & Risk Factors

Signs & Symptoms:

- Episodic memory loss, anxiety, depression & irritability.
- Communication barrier.
- Thinking and learning difficulties.
- Difficulty in swallowing.
- Difficulty in walking.
- Hallucinations.
- Sleep issues and sundowning.

Risk Factors:

- Age.
- Genetics.
- Family history.
- Certain systemic diseases.
