## INTRODUCTION



**Patient History and Observation are important.**

- Although the history in a vision screening may not be as extensive as in a comprehensive eye exam, it is still important to capture data such as **general health, ocular health, family health and even birth information for children.**



## INTRODUCTION



Patient History and Observation are important.

- Some patients may have excellent vision but **red flags** during the history may warrant a comprehensive eye exam.
- Simply observing a patient can provide practitioners with significant information where **gait, eye posture, head posture, personal hygiene and other outward physical signs** are concerned.

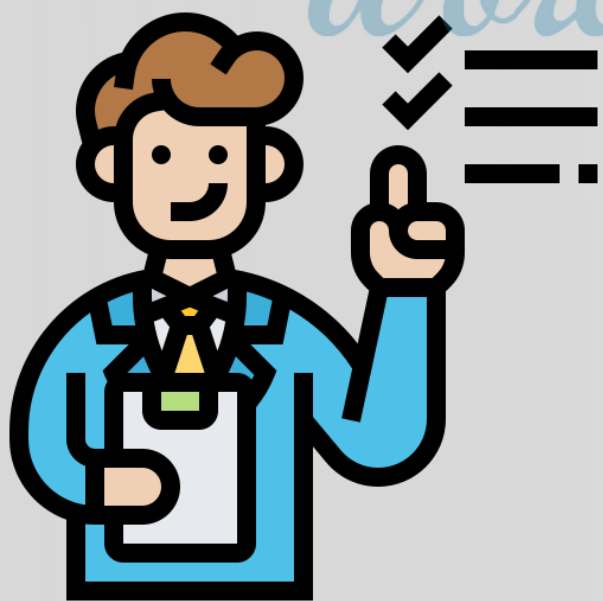


## TIPS



Visual Acuity is high in priority but still keep Ancillary Test in mind.

- Depending on the area (Rural or City) or maybe even age, it would be wise to have access to charts besides a Snellen Chart such as a **HOTV Chart**, a **LEA Symbols Chart** or even a **Tumbling E Chart** so that the visual acuity can be captured as accurate as possible.



## TIPS

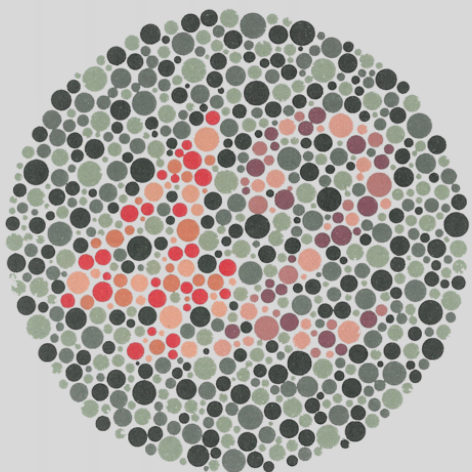


Visual Acuity is high in priority but still keep Ancillary Test in mind.



- And don't forget determining the urgency of the case might be done faster by having access to a **pinhole occluder**.

- **Colour Vision and Stereo Acuity** should still be done even though visual acuity might be excellent

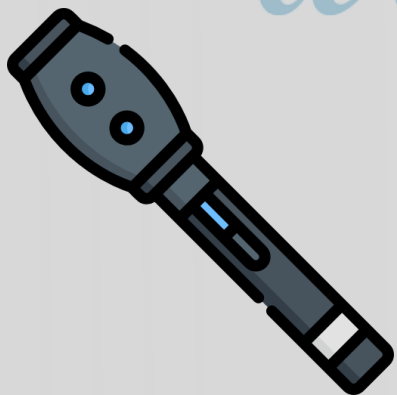


## TIPS

Another reason the  
Ophthalmoscope is our best friend!



- We already know the benefits of using the Ophthalmoscope for posterior segment evaluation, however for Vision Screenings the Ophthalmoscope can also give you **magnification for ocular surface structures** that may already be seen with the bare eye.



- For children especially, red reflex test must be paid attention to as missing **leukocoria can be devastating.**

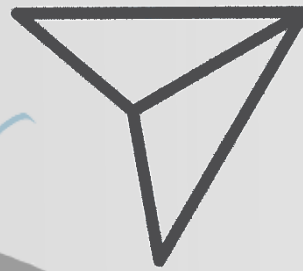

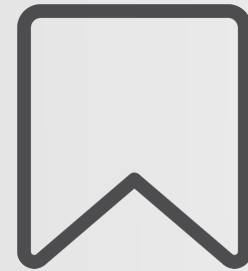

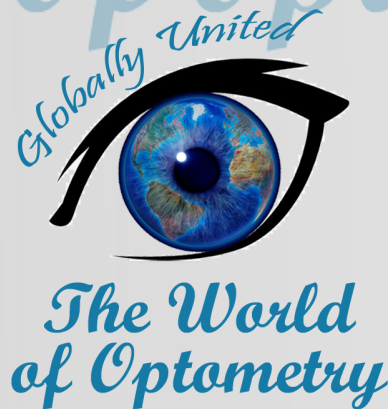
