Importance of Hand Hygiene

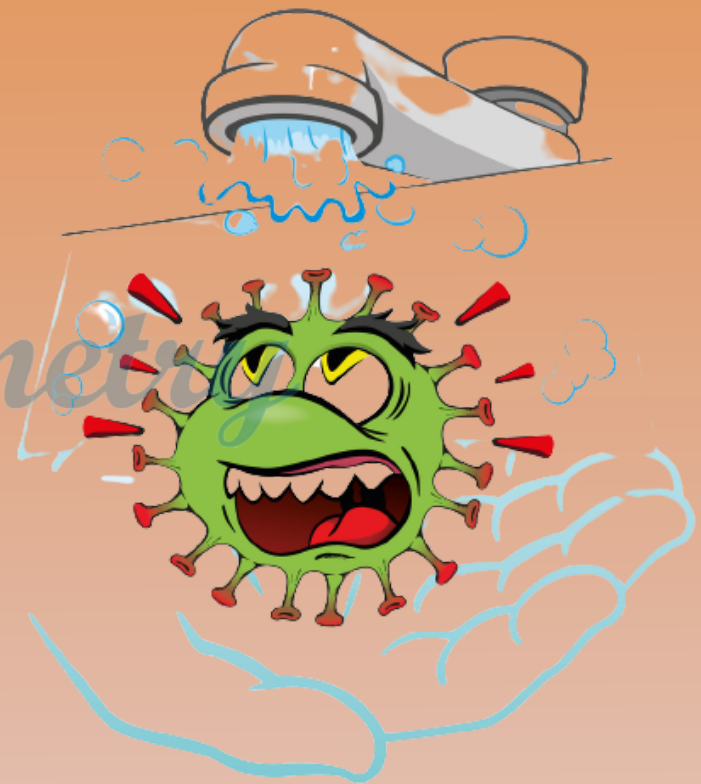
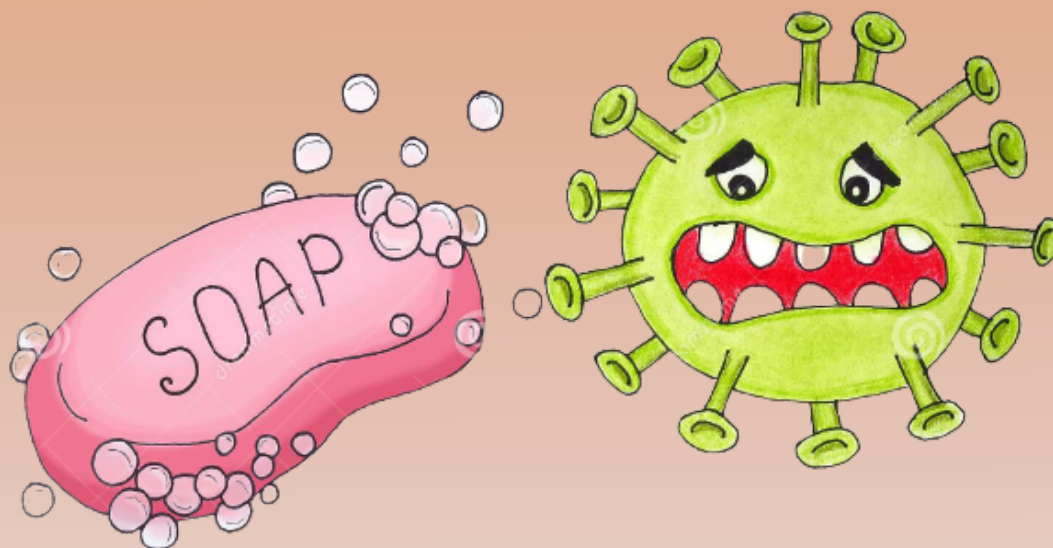

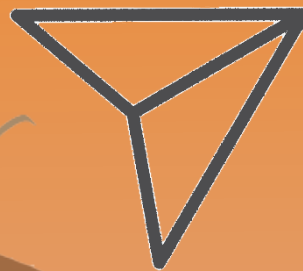
